



15 Tips for Teaching Sunday School

1. Start With the Word

Prepare your heart with prayer and Scripture before teaching.

2. Pray With Your Students

Begin and end class with simple, heartfelt prayers.

3. Keep Christ at the Center

Show how every story points to Jesus.

4. Know Your Students

Learn names and take an interest in their lives.

5. Use Multiple Learning Styles

Mix storytelling, visuals, crafts, songs, and movement.

6. Keep Lessons Age-Appropriate

Speak simply to little ones; dig deeper with older ones.

7. Encourage Participation

Ask open-ended questions and invite discussion.

8. Tell the Account Well

Use energy, expression, and joy in teaching the Bible account.

9. Be Consistent in Discipline

Set clear expectations and follow through gently.

10. Plan, but Stay Flexible

Come prepared, but be ready to adjust.

11. Use Visual Aids Wisely

Support the story without overshadowing it.

12. Connect the Lesson to Life

Show how God's Word speaks to everyday situations.

13. Repeat and Review

Reinforce learning by connecting lessons together.

14. Encourage Memory Verses

Even one verse a month can shape a child's faith.

15. Model the Joy of the Gospel

Let your love for Christ shine in all you do.
